"We pride ourselves on sourcing the best quality, local and seasonal produce and creating simple dishes that are full of flavour.

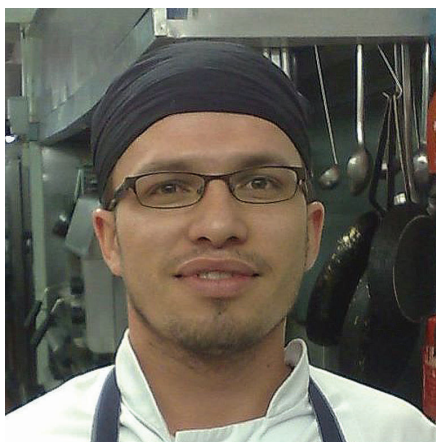
